## **Country: Nigeria**

- (1) The Federal Government of Nigeria through the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development has applied for financing from the World Bank and the L' Agence Francaise de Developpement (French Development Agency or AFD) and on-lent the financing to nineteen participating States (namely Abia, Akwa Ibom, Bauchi, Kano, Katsina, Kebbi, Kogi, Kwara, Ondo, Ogun, Oyo, Plateau, Sokoto, Niger, Gombe, Ekiti, Kaduna, Ebonyi and Osun) towards the cost of the Rural Access and Agricultural Marketing Project (RAAMP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Backlog Maintenance/Rehabilitation of 65.10km Rural roads in Ekiti State. This contract will be jointly financed by the International Development Association (IDA) and L'Agence Francaise de Developpement (French Development Agency or AFD). Procurement process will be governed by the World Bank's Procurement Regulations.
