- (d) Provide evidence of firm's corporate registration in Nigeria.
- (e) Provide annual audited account for the last three (3) years (2020-2022) to demonstrate the soundness of the bidder financial situation

- (f) Have liquidity and/or evidence of access to or availability of confirmed positive credit facilities of not less than N25m
