The shortlisting criteria are as follows:

- 1. Evidence of Incorporation/Registration with Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC)
- 2. Firm's overall experience, Qualifications and Managerial ability.
- 3. Financial/Account Information with evidence of Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2020, 2021 & 2022).
- 4. Company's audited account for the last three (3) years (2020, 2021 &2022).
- 5. Evidence of financial capacity to execute the project including Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed.
- 6. Evidence of the Firm's Registration with relevant professional/regulatory bodies and valid annual practicing license e.g.. COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON.
- 7. Firm's specific experience in Design and Civil Works Supervision in project to include verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including letters of awards, valuation certificates.
- 8. Availability of relevant personnel.

NOTE: The qualification and experience of key experts shall not be included in the shortlisting criteria. Key experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Paragraphs, 1.23, and 1.24 of the Guidelines for Procurement of Consultant Services under Islamic Development Bank Project Financing (the "Procurement Guidelines"), setting forth IsDB's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a subconsultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection method among a national shortlist (QCBS/LC) method set out in the Procurement Guidelines.
