- disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the National Information Technology Development Agency or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
- that no Director has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter;
- that the Company is not in receivership, the subject of any form of insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings or the subject of any form of winding up petition or proceedings;
- (h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2021, 2022 & 2023;
- (i) Reference Letter from a reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- (j) Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications such as COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.;
- (k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs (in size, nature & complexity) executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- (l) Consultancy Services: Evidence of Firm's current registration with the relevant regulatory professional body(ies) such as CPN & NITDA,
- (m) ICT jobs: Evidence of ISO 27001 and ISO 20000 Certifications;

- (n) Works: List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease Agreement;
