The RFP will also be accessible freely online.
- (5) The request for proposals document in English language may be purchased by interested eligible Proposers upon submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Twenty thousand Naira (NGN20,000.00) or in a convertible currency. The method of payment will be via Remita by generating a Remita Retrieval Reference (RRR) in favour of Sustainable Procurement, Environmental and Social Standards Enhancement (SPESSE) Project, National Universities Commission Project Implementation Unit. The technical proposal will be publicly opened in the presence of the invited Proposers/Consultants' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below at 12:00pm on 8 January 2024. A video conference link will also be provided to proposers who wish to attend virtually. All envelopes marked "FINANCIAL PART" shall remain

unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Purchaser until the second public Proposals opening.

- (7) All Proposals must be accompanied by a "Proposal Security" of Three million Naira (NGN3,000,000.00). Original copy of proposal security must accompany the proposal submission.
