(a) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC1.1 or CAC2 and CAC7. Business Name is also acceptable for Services;

(b) Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate (or Personal Income Tax

Clearance Certificates of all Partners in case of Business Name) for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2024; with minimum average annual turnover of N200 million;

(c) Evidence of Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2024 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 15 and above);

(d) Evidence of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2024 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 5 and above or the bidder's annual turnover is N50m and above);

(e) Evidence of Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2024;

(f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31st December, 2024 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.

(g) Sworn Affidavit:

disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Nigerian Press Council or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

 $\cdot~$  that no Director has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter;

• that the Company is not in receivership, the subject of any form of insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings or the subject of any form of winding up petition or proceedings;

 $\cdot$  that the company does not have existing loan or financial liability with a bank, other financial institution or third parry that is classified as doubtful, non-performance, bad or whose repayment portion has been outstanding for the last four (4) months;

(h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years -2021, 2022 & 2023;

(i) Reference Letter from a reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility of at least N300 million for the execution of the project when needed;

(j) Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications such as COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.;

(k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of awards, Valuation certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects of at least N150,000,000 satisfactorily or substantially completed as prime supplier/contractor between January 1, 2018 and the submission deadline;

(l) Works: List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease Agreement;

(m) Services: Evidence of Finn's current registration with relevant regulatory professional body(ies) such as Centre for Management Development for Training;

(n) For Supply of Equipment: Letter of Authorisation from the Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs);

(o) Electricity Jobs: Evidence of current Licence issued by Nigerian Electricity Management Services Agency (NEMSA);

(p) ICT jobs: Evidence of Firm's current Registration/Accreditation with the Computer Professionals Registration Council of Nigeria and National Information Technology Development Agency (NITDA);

(q) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided indicating among others the Lead Partner (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Clearance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Clearance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner);

**Note**: All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

Thereafter, put two sealed envelopes together in a bigger sealed envelope addressed to the Executive Secretary of the Nigerian Press Council, 26 Bissau Street Wuse Zone 6 Abuja marked with the name of the project/programme and Lot number. Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should bear the name and address of the bidder and drop in the designated Tender box (located at Servicom Unit, Nigerian Press Council) not later than **12:00 noon on Tuesday, 19 March, 2024.**
