• An average minimum company annual turnover of N1.5bn in the last 3 years.

 \cdot Experience in executing works of a similar nature and size preferably for any level of government or public sector organizations equivalent to the lot bidded for in the last 3 years

with evidence of letter of award or job completion certificate and contact person of the client.

• Audited Financial Statements for the last 3 years from a reputable and accredited accounting firm to demonstrate the financial capability of the Bidder in terms of profitability and adequate working capital.
