Scope

The scope of this Terms of Reference (ToR) includes.

- 1. Conducting routine preventive maintenance for all vehicles in Oxfam in Nigeria's fleet.
- 2. Diagnose and repair mechanical, electrical, and other issues as they arise.
- 3. Perform regular checks on essential components such as brakes, tires, engines, and fluids.
- 4. Ensure compliance with environmental and safety standards.
- 5. Provide detailed reports on the condition of each serviced vehicle and recommendations for any necessary repairs or replacements.

Objective

The primary objectives of this vehicle servicing engagement are:

- 1. Maintain the fleet's overall health and performance.
- 2. Identify and address any existing or potential mechanical issues.
