- The email will also provide payment and property pick-up information.
- Payments will be made by electronic transfer to the Embassy bank account provided. Payment should be made for the total amount due for all winning bids. The bank payment receipt must be presented at the time of property pick-up.
- $\cdot$  Payment must be received in the Embassy bank account by 5 P.M. Thursday, December 14, 2023 or the award will be forfeited.
- · All items are sold "as is" with no declaration made of serviceability. There will be no returns or refunds after payments are finalized.
- All successful bidders must pay customs duty before items can be removed from the warehouse area. Representatives from the Nigerian Customs Bureau will be on hand to collect duty on the pickup day. Proper Identification ID must be presented at pick-up site.
