The Federal Government of Nigeria has received financing for an amount of US\$ 109.18 million from the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) towards payments under the contracts for the procurement of equipment, furniture and fittings for the thirty (30) Bilingual Education Boarding Schools in the Nine (9) participating states.
2. The Universal Basic Education Commission now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for not more than one (1) lot for the procurement of equipment, furniture and fittings for the thirty (30) bilingual Education Boarding Schools in Nine (9) participating states.

Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on **9<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 by 12:00pm**. However, a soft copy of the financial bids in an excel format shall be submitted in a flash drive along with the hard copies of both technical and financial bids.
